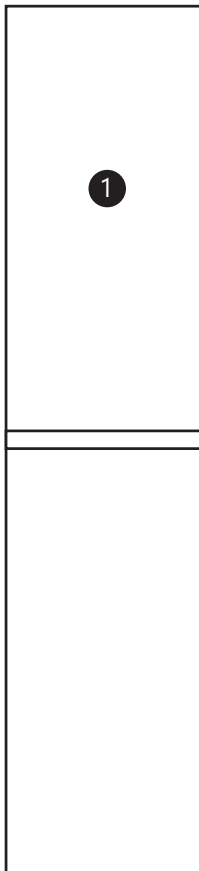

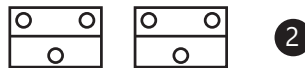
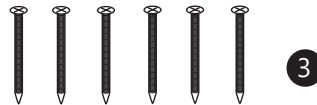
Before starting installation

Whilst these products are made to a high standard, please take every care when handling them to avoid surface damage.

Please remove all packaging and make sure no components are missing. The following components should be present:



ITEM	DESCRIPTION
1	Furniture unit
2	Wall fixing bracket x2
3	Screws x 6
4	Rawl plugs x 6

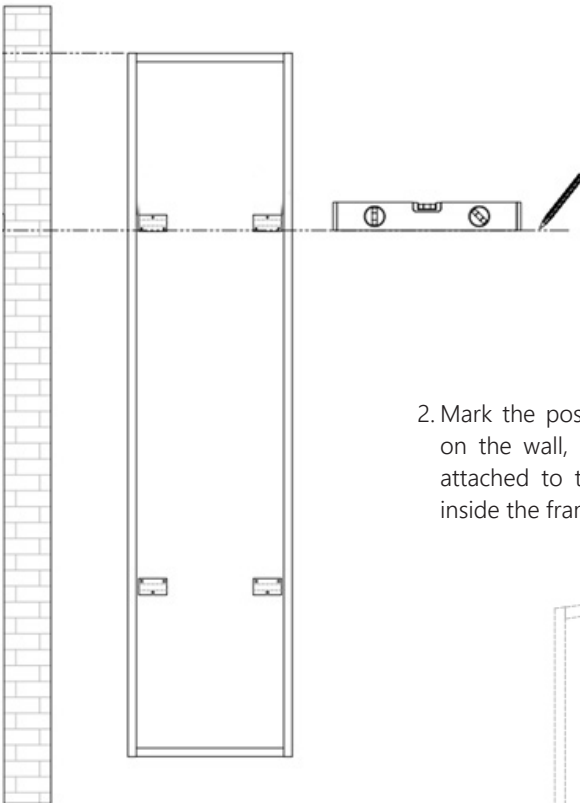


Installation

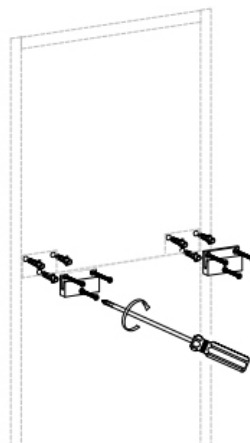
Before drilling any holes, please make sure you are aware of the location of electric wires and other pipes that may sit in or behind the wall.

It is recommended to install to a solid wall, but if fitting to a stud wall, the fixings must be secured into a stud, not only into the plasterboard.

1. Decide the desired height of the unit and mark a horizontal line on the wall that corresponds with the brackets that are fixed to the rear of the unit.

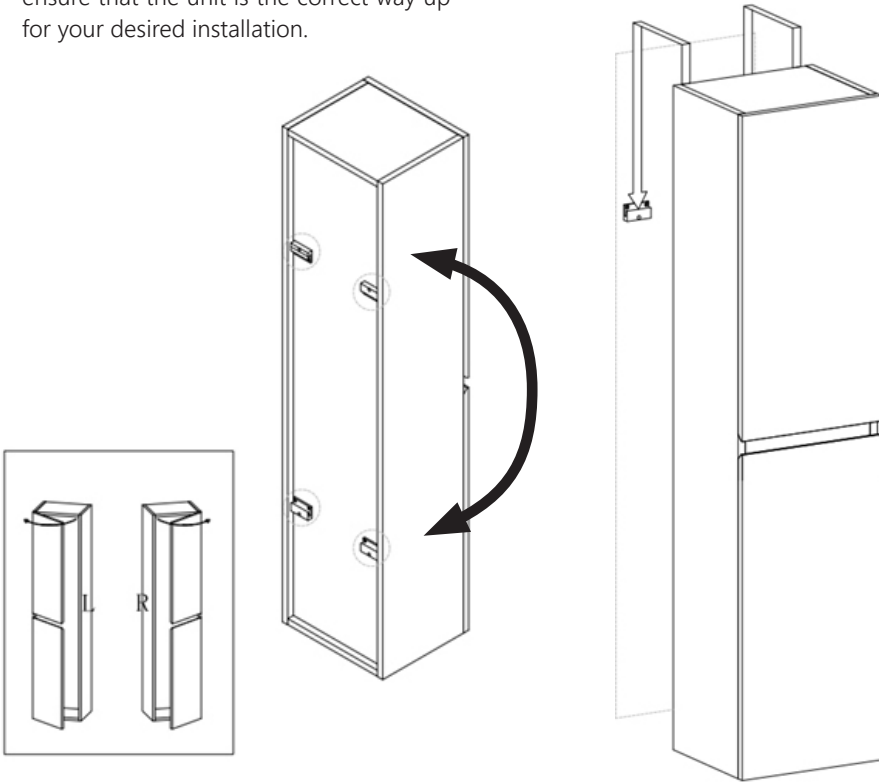


2. Mark the position of the wall fixing brackets on the wall, ensuring that when the unit is attached to the wall, the whole bracket fits inside the frame of the unit.



3. Depending on which way up it is mounted, the unit can have left hand opening doors or right hand opening doors so please ensure that the unit is the correct way up for your desired installation.

4. Lift the unit onto the wall and slide the brackets on the rear of the unit into the wall brackets.
